

Orev Snow Boarder

I knit this up and showed by two snow board-
ing sons (21 & 16), expecting them to NOT
like it. I was wrong, they both loved it, Nick
put it on and wore it the rest of the day. The
next morning I couldn't find it—he had hid-
den it in his room.

Sizes:

Fits any head size, made to measure.

Yarn:

100 yds bulky weight yarn or 200 yds worsted held
double. Yarn pictured is Malabrigo Chunky, color
VAA.

Needles:

Size 11 straight needle

Guage:

Not critical for this because you knit to
1.5 inches less than head circumfer-
ence.

Pattern:

Cast on 34 sts.

Row 1: *K2, P2, repeat from * across row ending with
a K2.

Row 2: *P2, K2, repeat from * across row ending
with a P2.

Repeat these two rows, this creates a stitch pattern
called 2x2 rib.

Continue until piece measures 1.5 inches less than
circumference of head. The average head is 21" -22".

Bind off.

Seam cast on end to bind off end to from a cylinder.
On one open end of cylinder thread yarn around
edge and cinch closed.

*~Note to all snow boarders: This had is to be worn
after you are done snow boarding and you have tak-
en your helmet off! Love Mom~*
